HYLAS OVERVIEW

From world class designer Bill Dixon the Hylas 57 is a perfect blend of classic Hylas, contemporary good looks and an embracing of the latest technology in construction and design. Twin helms and rudders for improved performance, a lighter weight cored hull for improved strength and insulation plus the Solent rig for ease of handling mark a new era in Hylas designs. With a 3 or 4 cabin layout this yacht will meet the needs of live-aboard couples or those planning extended cruises with friends and family. Primarily designed to be handled easily by a couple and fit the modern cruising lifestyle, this exciting new development stays true to the Hylas core competence of safely crossing oceans in comfort and style.

HISTORY OF HYLAS YACHTS

The Hylas brand has been proprietary of Queen Long Marine, the brand's creator, since 1985. The Queen Long shipyard was founded in 1978 by the Huang family and remains in full family operation and ownership to this day. The 117,300 sq ft shipyard is home to a 32,000 sq ft main construction hall, dedicated 18,000 sq ft laminating hall, a large paint facility, extensive design and administration offices and their famous on-site 10ft-deep full-sized yacht testing tank complete with a thriving population of ornamental Koi Carp. Some 76 shipwrights, laminators, engineers, electricians and painters are employed directly by the shipyard to build the Hylas range of motor and sailing yachts, of which over 500 have been launched to date.
