Her rugged exterior features side decks and a rear platform entry with large companionways all around, plus a Portuguese bridge outside the trawler style wheelhouse.





The Bering 65 is a rugged and classic looking steel yacht capable of any ocean crossing. She is quiet, strong and leaves a graceful wake underway. Her displacement is over 200,000 pounds (107 tons) and with 5,000 gallons (17,000 liters) of fuel you can cruise continuously for thousands of miles.

The main deck saloon features built-in seating on both sides, with a large dinette to starboard and an entertainment center forward of the settees. Large double doors aft can be opened when maximum ventilation is desired or when entertaining large groups.

A staircase forward leads to the lower staterooms, and another one to the elevated galley and command centre. Forward of the galley we find the beautiful, fully equipped pilothouse. The presentation is nautically timeless, a feeling enhanced by the forward raked trawler-style windscreens.





Bering 65's interior plan includes three spacious staterooms, each with its own private en-suite head, and a crew quarters for two. Bering offers a variety of lavishly crafted woodwork and a diversity of counter, flooring and upholstery selections for each custom made boat.
