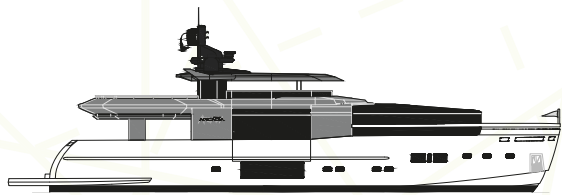

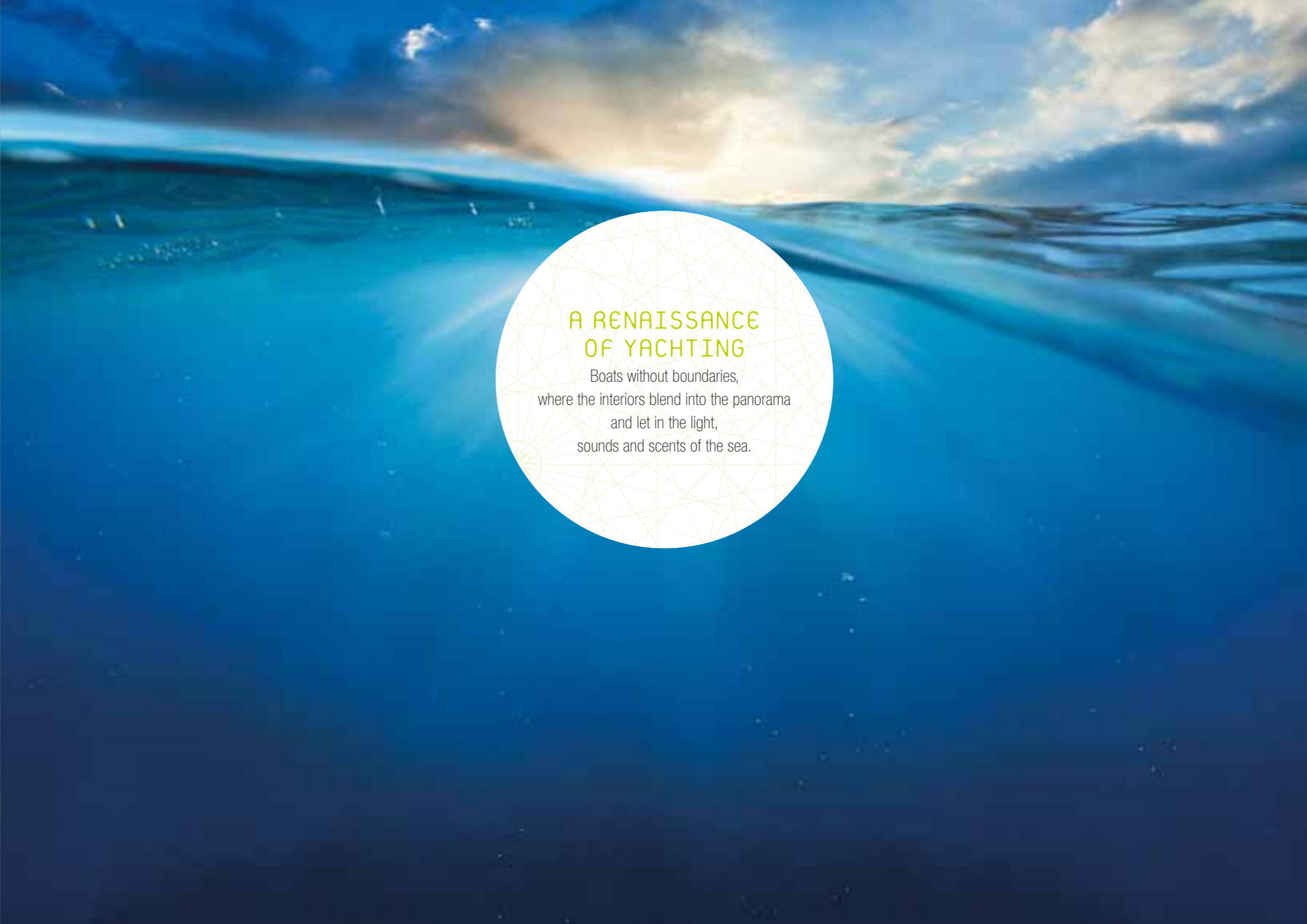

MAIN SALON

One-of-a-kind, with sliding

A 36-square-metre area that can be easily adapted to the owner's requirements. The crew operations area is kept separate for total privacy.



SEMI-PLANING HULL

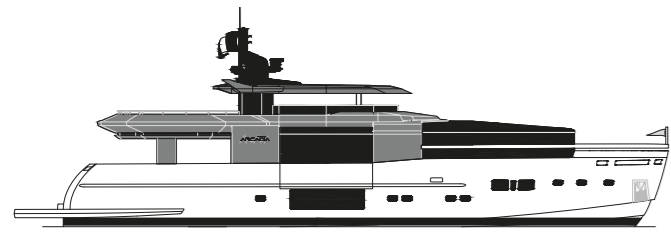
The hull is optimised to ensure a cruising speed of 12-14 knots, utmost comfort and low consumption, up to 30% less than those of other main players.



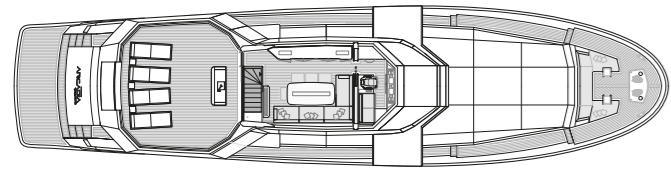
SOLAR PANELS

More than 50 square metres of solar panels that can generate more than 4 kW of power, combining the ultimate pleasure of life on-board with full respect for the environment.

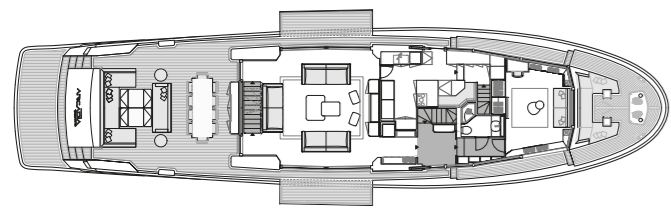

OUR FLEET ARCHITECTURE

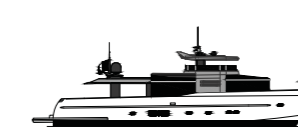
